It's already been an interesting start to the year. But we are overcomers and we are determined to make it a great year! With that being said please give Carla and I a little bit of grace, as we will also give you and your children, as we learn to navigate all the changes we have to make this year.

The first few weeks of school are focused entirely on building relationships, for this reason we don't ask much academically from children. We also spend a lot of time focused on establishing the rules and learning how to manage the rules. When we put in this work from the start it pays off in spades down the road!

Separation on the first day of school

The first day of school can be tough for some kiddos, but the most important thing you can do to help your child is to be honest with them about what to expect, follow through with what you say you are going to do, and then be consistent in that! Having a goodbye routine is helpful: this can be as simple as giving a hug and a kiss, saying goodbye and encouraging them to have fun. Or asking them what they're going to play with when they get in the classroom. Routines make children feel safe and Carla and I are here to help. Since parents aren't allowed in the classroom this year please allow Carla or I to take your child into the classroom if they need a little help. Don't worry your child will settle down in a very short period of time, if they don't we will let you know via text.

This process is pretty easy, all you have to do is fill out the form from your car at drop off and again at pick up. The link is also on the preschool website and I will have QR codes out front when you get here, just open your camera and let it hover over the code, the website should pop up.

- Please put all other belongings in your child's backpack (spare clothes, boots, emergency kits, hats/gloves, and sunscreen).
